

The CRFJ has its origin in the French Archeological Mission funded by the French archeologist Jean Perrot in Jerusalem in 1952. It became a "cooperative research program" "Prehistory and Protohistory of the Asian Near-East" (1964) then as a permanent mission of the CNRS, the « French Prehistorical Research Center of Jerusalem » (1974). The CRFJ takes his actual name in 1985; it becomes pluridisciplinary and extends its research field to all social sciences and humanities.




3 RESEARCH ORIENTATIONS:

ARCHEOLOGIES OF THE SOUTHERN LEVANT



Archeology is the funding pillar of the activity and the recognition of the CRFJ. Historically focused on prehistory, the archeological research has been diversified and includes since then the Bronze and the Stone Ages, the Byzantine period and the Crusades.
